

Tour "Introduction to Uzbekistan" 2 days / 1 night "TASHKENT"

Beautiful cities – the pearls of the Great Silk Road – Tashkent and Samarkand, recognized by UNESCO as part of the World Heritage, are now presented in the context of a sightseeing ART-gastronomic paradise.

Day 1

00:05 – Arrival in Tashkent from Shymkent. 8:00 – Meeting at the "Zhibek Zholu" checkpoint.

Sightseeing program in Tashkent:

- Visit to the holy sites of Tashkent:
- Khast-Imam Square, the religious center of Tashkent and one of the shrines of the Muslim world. The Khast-Imam complex includes the Barak-Khan Madrasah (16th century), the Mausoleum of Saint Abu Bakr Kaffal Shashi (16th century), the Tilla Sheikh Mosque (19th century), the Al-Bukhari Islamic Institute, and a library of oriental manuscripts containing the precious Quran of Caliph Uthman.
- Kukeldash Madrasah the largest of Tashkent's 23 madrasahs, with a main portal 197 meters high.
- Mui-Mubarak Madrasah (19th century), home to the unique artifact the oldest Quran of Uthman.
 - "Tule Biy" Mausoleum
 - "White Mosque"

Lunch at the "Beshkazan" Plov Center – a unique place where you can taste any of the 6 types of plov prepared here. More than 4 tons of plov are cooked daily in 13 cauldrons, the largest of which can hold over 2 tons of rice.

Visit to the "Zangi-ata" complex (a disciple of Ahmed Yasawi and the third caliph).

Architectural complex "Suzuk-ata" (grandson of Ahmed Yasawi).

Optional visit to the Magic City amusement park with fountain shows and an aquarium.

Accommodation in the hotel.

Overnight in Tashkent.

Day 2 00:05 - Tashkent

Breakfast.

Full-day sightseeing program in Tashkent: "Squares and Parks of Tashkent":

- Amir Timur Square
- Visit to "Istiqlol" Square and Alisher Navoi Park.
- Monument of Courage
- Tashkent TV Tower (ticket for the observation deck is not included)
- Ride on the Tashkent Metro
- Eastern Bazaar "Chorsu" the oldest bazaar in Central Asia. "Chorsu" means "Four Corners."

We will also visit Tashkent Venice and take a gondola ride. "Anhor-Venice" (ticket not included).

Lunch (or dinner by choice) at the "Gijduvan" cafe, where you can try A'lat samsa and "Balaza" shurpa.

Farewell at the "Zhibek Zholu" checkpoint.
